Rules

1. All memberships are extended to the member's spouse and children and are allowed one (1) vote per family. Member's children are welcome as passengers but may not drive until age 21.
2. Always abide by "Tread Lightly" principles.
3. Travel only on legal and established trails.
4. NEJeep has a no tolerance drug and alcohol policy before and during trail rides for drivers and passengers.
5. No discharge of firearms on trail rides or at any location not designated as a safe firing range.
6. Perform vehicle inspection and maintenance before each trail ride.
7. As a member of NEJeep, you will receive a member sticker to display on your Jeep. Because NEJeep strives to enhance the reputation of the wheeler and off-highway driving and you are a representative of NEJeep, you will be expected to drive your Jeep in a safe and courteous manner at all times.
8. All vehicles must be equipped with a full size spare, fire extinguisher, rear and front tow points, tow strap (no metal hooks), and CB radio to participate in trail rides. NEJeep keeps a limited supply of handheld CBs for member use on official trail runs and are available via the Trails Director upon request. In the event that we have a higher demand than supply, requests are on a first-come, first-served basis.
9. Suggested equipment/supplies:
 - a. Food and water for yourself and your passengers
 - b. First-aid kit including any medications you may require
 - c. Spare parts and fluids
 - d. Bucket for fluid spills
 - e. Trash bags – carry out more than you brought in
 - f. Roll cage
 - g. Winch
10. Do not leave cigarette butts on the ground.
11. Members shall immediately notify the club secretary with any change in status of driver's license, registration, or insurance.
